- 2. Shannon Brook update
  - a. Shannon has sold her tattoo business and is relinquishing her position with the board. We have 7 voting positions in place, and 2 vacancies. Will discuss at a future meeting a possible by-election to fill those vacancies.
- 3. Councillor Cowsill's plaque
  - a. Darren spoke with Scott, he is honored to have the plaque placed in Hespeler. He is happy to wait until good weather arrives and we will plan a simple ceremony.

### Holiday Season Lights Update - Darren/Tara

1. 5 vendors to take over lights were contacted. We received just one quote. It is over \$8200, and includes new lights for focus tree and Cenotaph Park trees, and storage for all lights.

### Finance Update - Ken/Darren

- 1. Darren we have 3 unplanned costs
  - a. \$2700 claw back from City for overpayments for 2022
  - b. \$8200 for Holiday Lights, there was just \$2000 in the budget
  - c. \$2100 for a new controller for the dam lights, which was damaged by vandalism.
  - d. NOTE: The Holiday lights and controller are eligible for the city's 50/50 cost sharing program and in total is a \$5100 budget hit.
  - e. A separate budget meeting is needed to make this work.

- 7. Dam Lights cellular remote control Cory
- 8. Start Holiday Lights planning in July
